No taxes are levied by the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas, for operating, maintaining, equipping, and improving the hospital. Through the years, SWMC has become a regional medical center serving patients from a five-state region of Kansas, Colorado, Oklahoma, Texas, and New Mexico.

SWMC Launches Patient Family Advisory Council



SWMC launched its first PFAC the end of April 2021. The council consists of patients and family members of patients who have received services at the hospital. The mission of the SWMC PFAC is to facilitate collaboration between patients, family members, hospital staff, administration, and physicians in order to enhance the overall patient care experience. 
